- b) Writing off losses of stores/money/assets not due to theft, fraud, negligence above Rs 15 lakhs and above Rs 03 lakh in other cases.
- c) Reimbursement of medical expenses (hospitalization cases) in respect of MP-IDSA employees' dependent parents above Rs 05 lakh
- d) DG's personal cases like leave, tour abroad etc.
- e) Approval of Awards (K Subrahmanyam and President MP-IDSA's Award for Excellence for Young Scholar).
- f) Appointment of Distinguished Fellow.

MATTERS REQUIRING APPROVAL OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, MP-IDSA

- 1. Purchase of Immovable Property
- 2. Capital expenditure (civil works/equipment's) above Rs. 70 lakhs
- 3. Adoption of audited Annual Accounts and Annual Report of the previous year for onward submission to the Annual general Meeting
- 4. Issue of general direction for research activities at the Institute
- 5. Creation of new posts
- 6. Appointment/recruitment/termination of all personnel in the Pay Band 3 and above1
- 7. Hiring of consultant/project related personnel for the period exceeding one year for specific task/projects-over the strength approved
- 8. Deputation cases of MP-IDSA's scholars abroad for attending conference, workshop, meetings etc. subject to political clearance from MEA & FCRA clearance where MP-IDSA would be required to meet the expenditure on foreign travels, boarding and lodging.
- 9. Grant of leave & lien to MP-IDSA's scholars for availing fellowship outside for the period exceeding six months
- 10. All policy matters and formulation of rules and regulations for the Institute
- 11. Any matter directed by President, MP-IDSA to be brought for consideration by EC.
