Iranian Military Adviser Martyred in Israeli Attack on Syria, IRGC Vows Tough Response

Iranian Navy's 86th Fleet Docks at Cape Town Port in South Africa

Iranian Navy Shoos off US Spy Aircraft in Sea of Oman

The Iranian Army's Navy identified and warned off a US spy aircraft after it crossed the country's borders near the Sea of Oman.

The EP-3E aircraft, with four turboprop engines, is made by the US military aircraft manufacturer Lockheed Martin.

US Deploys Guided-Missile Submarine Amid Tensions With Iran

The U.S. Navy has deployed a guidedmissile submarine capable of carrying up to 154 Tomahawk missiles to the Middle East, a spokesman said Saturday, in what appeared to be a show of force toward Iran following recent tensions. The Navy rarely acknowledges the location or deployment of submarines. Cmdr. Timothy Hawkins, a spokesman for the 5th Fleet based in the Gulf nation of Bahrain, declined to comment on the submarine's mission or what had prompted the deployment. He said the nuclear-powered submarine, based in Kings Bay in the U.S. state of Georgia, passed through the Suez Canal Friday. "It is capable of carrying up to 154 Tomahawk land-attack cruise missiles and is deployed to the U.S. 5th Fleet to help ensure regional maritime security and stability," Hawkins said.

vehicle (UAV), dubbed Me'raj 532, with a piston engine has a one-way range of 450 kilometers. The kamikaze drone, which designed and manufactured by young Iranian experts, he added, is capable of flying up to a height of 12,000 feet for 3 hours and taking off from a vehicle.

Iranian Army unveils jammer drone

The jammer drone is the Army's first UAV with the capability to operate and support electronic warfare and electronic offense the enemy's communication against networks, Press TV reported.

Senior Commander: Iran Equips Helicopters with New Precision Missiles

Saab to deliver anti-tank systems to NATO

Swedish Saab announced that it has signed framework agreements with NATO Support and Procurement Agency (NSPA) for the Carl-Gustaf M4 weapon system and the AT4 anti-armour weapon with a total value of approximately \$33.5 million. Last month, Saab announced it will sell weapon systems (multi-purpose shoulder launched weapons, short-range air defense systems and radars) to a western country, in a deal worth over \$761 million.

Israeli Navy features Sa'ar 6- class corvette in int'l "Noble Dina" exercise for first time

The international naval exercise "Noble Dina 2023," lead by the Israeli Navy, wrapped up after two weeks on Thursday. The IDF communicated that this represents another step forward in strengthening international and regional cooperation in order to guarantee maritime freedom and defense. This is an annual exercise, which takes place in the Mediterranean and

includes both maritime and aerial drills. This year, it included forces from Israel, Greece, Cyprus, Italy, France and the US. Israeli forces included two Sa'ar 4.5- class missile boats, a Sa'ar 5- class corvette, and a Sa'ar 6- class corvette – which made its debut appearance at Noble Dina. Other Israeli forces included a Dolphin-class submarine and Israeli Air Force fighter jets and helicopters.

Israel to help Finland, NATO's newest member, with aerial defense

The Ministry of Defense has authorised the Finnish Defense Forces to procure the David's Sling system as the next long-range

air defense system of Finland. Israel's Rafael Advanced Defense Systems will deliver the system. The value of the procurement without value added tax is approximately 316 million euros. The David's Sling system is a long-range air defense system jointly developed by Israel and the United States. The sale of the system to Finland will require a sales release by the United States Government. The system will extend the operational range of Finland's ground-based defense capabilities significantly. The minimum flight altitude requirement of the system was set at 15 000 meters in the request for quotation.

Greece signs \$400m contract with Israel for anti-tank missiles

Israel signed a NIS 1.44 billion (\$400 million) deal to sell Spike anti-tank Greece. missiles to Israel's Defense Ministry said on Monday, just days after reaching a similar-sized deal to provide air defenses to newly-inducted NATO member Finland. The Spike is a guided anti-tank missile used by many EU and NATO countries produced by Israeli state-owned defense contractor Rafael. "The Spike missiles will strengthen the Greek army's portfolio of operational tools and we expect further expansion through collaborations in the near future," said Rafael CEO Yoav Har-Even. Israel's defense minister said the agreement reinforces ties between the countries.

The official press release of the Federal Council said that Armsuisse carried out a market analysis and subsequently requested information on anti-tank guided missiles from various European and American manufacturers. The information on which these requests focused included, for example, function, the effect, technical data on the operations system, the potential integration in the existing infrastructure, and the commercial framework conditions.

Israeli Light weapons in Cypriot Special forces

A tweet on Twitter reveals the inventory of the personal light weapons in a Cypriot Special forces squad and it is all Israeli.

According to the photo in the tweet - which deals with the visit of the President of Cyprus to the unit - in the 8-soldier squad of the Raider Command unit, there are 2 "Negev" NG5SF light machine guns, one Micro Tavor X95FT Assault rifle with a barrel length of 419 mm that is used as a light Designated Marksman Rifle (DMR), three Micro Tavor X95FT Assault rifle with a barrel length of 330 mm as well as two 40

mm GL40 grenade launchers installed on Micro Tavor Assault rifles. All weapons are manufactured by the Israeli company IWI. The Raider unit is the Special Forces unit of the Cypriot National Guard and is stationed in Larnaca. The unit's missions today are mountain/ border patrols, combat search and rescue, paratrooping operations, hostage rescue and Close-quarters combat.

France informs Hezbollah that the Franjieh / Salam barter deal is dead

Hezbollah was informed that the proposed barter deal which calls for Marada Movement chief Suleiman Franjieh as President of the Republic and ambassador Nawaf Salam as Prime Minister is dead, according to a report by Lebanon Debate web site. Salam is a Lebanese diplomat, jurist, and academic. He was elected on 9 November 2017 as iudge on International Court of Justice for the 2018– 2027 term .He served as Lebanon's Ambassador and Permanent Representative to the United Nations in New York from 2007 to 2017, during which period he held the positions of President of the Security Council and Vice President of the General Assembly. This development comes after France decided to invite more presidential candidates. The list of candidates that will be receiving the invitation to come to Paris has not been made public. France reportedly is coordinating this issue with its partners.

Israel says Hamas behind rocket barrage from Lebanon; IDF expected to retaliate

Several mortars impacted near the northern Israeli town of Metula, the Israeli military confirmed, according Israeli media reports

Local security officials instructed residents of the town near the border with Lebanon to remain in shelters amid sounds explosions. The Israel Defense Forces says several mortars were found following scans of the area. The attack did not cause any injuries or damage. Opposition leader Yair Lapid responds to the escalation in violence and blasted the Israeli government. "The extreme and irresponsible behavior of the current government led to a serious damage to deterrence," the Yesh Atid leader says. Despite his criticism of the government he said" opposition will give the government full backing for a harsh response by the IDF and the security forces."

Dozens of rockets fired from Lebanon into Israel

Dozens of rockets were fired from Lebanon into Israel on Thursday, the Israeli military said, in a major escalation that comes amid tensions over Israeli police raids at the al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem. It was the largest such attack since a 2006 war between the two countries left around 1,200 Lebanese people and 165 Israelis dead in an exchange of fire that involved a nationwide Israeli aerial assault, and a naval and aerial blockade, after Hezbollah militants crossed

from Lebanon into Israel and ambushed two Israeli Army vehicles, killing three soldiers and capturing two other soldiers. Israel closed its northern airspace in the wake of the barrage. No deaths were reported as of Thursday afternoon, and it is not yet known which group in Lebanon launched the rockets. Videos posted on social media showed rockets streaking through the skies over northern Israel, and the sounds of explosions in the distance.

UN peacekeepers in Lebanon appealed for calm late Friday after supporters of the Iran backed Hezbollah militant group clashed with Israeli border guards as Iran and Arab countries marked Jerusalem Day. The annual commemoration is staged in support of the Palestinian cause, and earlier in the day Palestinian factions paraded in the Burj al-Barajneh refugee camp in Lebanon, a Hezbollah stronghold. Later, Hezbollah supporters approached the border fence with Israel in south Lebanon and placed one of the Shiite group's flags there. "UNIFIL peacekeepers observed a crowd of 50 or 60 individuals throwing stones and placing a Hezbollah flag in the technical fence," deputy UN Interim Force in Lebanon spokesperson Kandice Ardiel said.

Russia Navy frigate Admiral Gorshkov visits Saudi Arabia for first time ever

Navy Recognition, April 6, 2023

Admiral Gorshkov left Murmansk, Russia, on January 4 and traveled to South Africa, where it conducted naval exercises before heading to Chabahar, Iran, for further military exercises. Last month, Russia announced naval exercises with China and Iran in the Arabian Sea, aiming to strengthen ties with both countries. The ship also held a training drill in the Indian Ocean, focusing on seeking and destroying submarines using its Ka-27 helicopter. After completing its mission in the Indian Ocean, the ship sailed to Djibouti and then to Jeddah, marking its historic first visit to Saudi Arabia. The frigate has a displacement of 4,550 tons (standard) to 5,400 tons (full), with a length of 135 meters and a beam of 16 meters. She is powered by a CODAG propulsion system with 2 10D49 cruise diesel engines and 2 M90FR boost gas turbines, producing a total of 65,400 shp (48,800 kW) and allowing her to reach a speed of 29.5 knots (54.6 km/h; 33.9 mph).

Israel shoots down unmanned aircraft from Syria

Flagship-to-be Anadolu LHD enters Turkish Navy's inventory next week

Türkiye's largest warship, the multipurpose amphibious assault ship Anadolu, is set to be delivered to the Naval Forces Command Monday, marking a significant milestone for the country's defense industry, the head of the top defense body said Thursday. Ismail Demir, head of the Defense Industries Presidency (SSB), spoke during a signing ceremony to construct three new frigates under the MILGEM (National Ship) project. The MILGEM project was initiated in 2000 to locally design and build a new line of multipurpose frigates and corvettes to replace the older ones. So far, the commissioning of four corvettes and one frigate, the Istanbul

frigate, has been carried out. Demir previously said that Türkiye was planning to simultaneously build the three new I-class frigates designed by Turkish engineers.

Israel signs \$400M deal to sell anti-tank missiles to Greece

Israel's defense minister said the agreement reinforces ties between the countries. Last week Israel and Rafael said they would provide the advanced air-defense system David's Sling to Finland, after it officially joined NATO on April 4.

Türkiye commissions its largest warship, world's 1st drone carrier

"The TCG Anadolu ... is the world's first warship in its field where UAVs can land and take off," Erdoğan said, stressing that the vessel would host many of Türkiye's manned and unmanned aerial vehicles.

Houthis agree to restore UN-brokered truce, negotiate with opponents

The Houthis have agreed to restore a lapsed, UN-brokered ceasefire in Yemen for six months, discuss the exchange of all the prisoners they hold, and engage in direct negotiations with the Yemeni government, Yemeni government officials and local

media said on Thursday. In return, the Houthis will get salary payments for civil servants in areas they control and an easing of restrictions on Sanaa airport and Hodeidah port. Saudi officials informed Yemen's Presidential Leadership Council in Riyadh that in addition to the truce and prisoner swap, the Houthis had agreed during direct talks to negotiate with the Yemeni government for six months, under the auspices of the UN, and discuss a two-year transitional period, two Yemeni government officials told Arab News.
