Washington calls Iran's response "not constructive", without even reading it

The US, which is believed by experts to be responsible for the current situation of the nuclear deal by its unwise withdrawal, has called Iran's responses to the latest effort to revive the 2015 accord "not constructive," while an official of US Department of State has said that they have not even read it yet. According to "The Times", Vedant Patel, a department spokesperson, didn't elaborate on the remarks Thursday night but added that US officials were still looking at the response, which Iran had submitted to the European Union. The EU has drafted a proposal to rescue the agreement, abandoned by President Donald Trump in 2018, and energy traders have been closely watching to see whether there will be a breakthrough.

Iran's near weapons-grade uranium stock grows, probe stuck -IAEA reports

Iran's stock of uranium enriched to up to 60%, close to weapons-grade, has grown to well above the amount that by one definition is enough, if enriched further, for a nuclear bomb, a quarterly report by the UN atomic watchdog showed on Wednesday. Iran's uranium enriched to up to 60% and in the form of uranium hexafluoride, the gas that centrifuges enrich, is estimated to have grown by 12.5 kg to 55.6 kg since the last quarterly International Atomic Energy Agency report issued on May 30, the IAEA report to member states seen by Reuters said.

Iran offers completion of gas pipeline project with Pakistan: APP

The IP gas pipeline was a key project in that regard and both countries realized its importance. The ambassador said Iran was already exporting 100 megawatts of electricity to Pakistan for meeting the power needs (of its bordering areas) and it would be increased in the future.

US blacklists 1 Iranian individual, 4 companies for fear of development in drone industry

While Vienna Talks are waiting for Washington's decision and the White House is claiming a diplomatic approach towards Iran, the US Department of Treasury has blacklisted an Iranian individual and 4 companies for fear of developing drone industry. "OFAC is designating three companies and one individual involved in the research, development, production, and procurement of Iranian UAVs and UAV components, including the Shahed series of drones, for Iran's Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) and its Aerospace Force (IRGC ASF) and Navy," US Department of Treasury said. It claimed that Tehran-based

Safirán Airport Services (Safirán) has coordinated Russian military flights between Iran and Russia, including those associated with transporting Iranian UAVs, personnel, and related equipment from Iran to Russia.

Iran to launch Zafar-2 Satellite soon

Zafar 2 is the fourth satellite built by IUST, Anbia said, adding that 64 pieces are used to make a satellite. The IUST is privileged for making satellites due to owning different technologies and being capable of meeting the needs of the country in this field, according to Anbia.

Iran to conduct final test of Bavar-373 in coming days

on Saturday that Iran's Army to carry out the final test of the homegrown Bavar-373 air defense system within next few days and the range of this system will top 300 km. Brigadier General Sabahifard in his remarks, highlighted the significance of air defense in defending dignity, prestige and integrity of the establishment of the Islamic Republic of Iran, adding that Iran's Army Air Defense Force has made every effort to safeguard and preserve the country's airspace. He said that the homegrown Bavar-373 defense missile system is capable of detecting and targeting the enemies' aircraft beyond the Iranian borders, as well as simultaneously detecting up to 300 targets, tracking 60 targets and engaging six targets. Bavar 373, as the first Iranian indigenous long-range defense system which was unveiled in August 2019, is a mobile missile defense system designed to intercept and destroy incoming hostile targets.

Israel warns over Iran uranium capability with nuclear talks at halt

Tensions around a breakdown in talks between Iran and the US over Tehran's nuclear programme escalated on Monday when Israel's defence minister, Benny Gantz, claimed that Iran would be able to produce enough enriched uranium to make three nuclear warheads within a few weeks. Gantz also revealed a map detailing 10 facilities in Syria allegedly being used to arm Iran and its proxies, including Hezbollah. He said the facilities represented a threat to Israel's security. Iran

for its part claimed it had manufactured a stealth drone that could hit major Israeli cities. At the same time, the UN nuclear inspectorate chief, Rafael Grossi, said it would be extremely hard to restore the knowledge his organisation had lost about Iranian nuclear activities owing to his inspectors and cameras being barred from key sites by Iran.

Drugs, militias form explosive mix on Iraq-Iran border

Last year, the directorate tasked with drug control in Maysan province had urged that more detention facilities be built as soon as possible due to a sharp rise in the number of drug-related arrests and the inability to house all those arrested, as Al-Monitor reported at that time.

Turkish intel chief pursues multiple goals in Baghdad

Turkey's intelligence chief Hakan Fidan became the country's first official to hold high-level talks in Baghdad after bilateral tensions shot up in July. While Fidan's visit was aimed at soothing the tensions, it was also a Turkish attempt to exert influence in the Iraqi political crisis. Tensions spiked

over a bloody attack on Parakh, a tourist retreat in Iraqi Kurdistan, that Iraqi leaders blamed on the Turkish military. The July 20 artillery strike killed nine civilians and injured more than 30 others, sparking anger against Turkey across the Iraqi political spectrum. In a remarkably stern reaction, Shiite leader Muqtada al-Sadr — a key actor in the government crisis in Iraq — called for canceling all security arrangements with Turkey, halting air and land traffic between the two countries and taking action against Turkey at the United Nations.

Israeli attacks squeeze Iranian aerial supplies to Syria, sources say

Israel has intensified strikes on Syrian airports to disrupt Tehran's increasing use of aerial supply lines to deliver arms to allies in Syria and Lebanon including Hezbollah, regional diplomatic and intelligence sources told Reuters. Tehran has adopted air transport as a more reliable means of ferrying military equipment to its forces and allied fighters in Syria, following disruptions to ground transfers. Israel has long seen its foe Iran's deepening entrenchment in Syria as a national security threat and is widening the scope of its strikes to hit at this new transport method, the diplomatic and intelligence sources said. The latest strikes on Wednesday night damaged Aleppo airport just before the arrival of a plane from Iran, a commander in an Iran-backed regional alliance who was familiar with the incident told Reuters.

Türkiye's 1st indigenous turbofan engine to be launched next year

Türkiye's first indigenous turbofan engine, which is also the most powerful engine produced by the country, will be launched by the beginning of 2023. Mahmut Faruk Aksit, CEO of the Tusas Engine Industries, told Anadolu Agency the engine will have a 6,000 pound-force dry thrust, equivalent to around 6,000 horsepower. Speaking at the country's largest technology fair Teknofest in the Black Sea province of Samsun, he said the engine is being showcased for the first time. Two years after conceiving the project, the design phase is over and the manufacturing phase

is underway, he said. The target is to launch the product in the first quarter of 2023, he added. The engine is compatible with assault boats, pipelines for pumping natural gas, or the newly designed Turkish fighter drone Kizil Elma.

Romania wants to buy 18 Turkish Bayraktar TB2 UCAVs for \$300M

Currently, Romania does not have state-of-the-art combat drones in its inventory.

Greece gets 1st pair of upgraded F-16 jets amid tensions with Türkiye

The first pair of upgraded F-16 military jets was delivered to Greece's air force on Monday under a \$1.5 billion program to modernize its fighter fleet, which comes amid increasing tensions with neighboring Türkiye. The two F-16s presented at the Tanagra air base northwest of Athens are the first of 83 to be refitted with advanced electronics, radar and weapons capabilities by late 2027 by Greece's Hellenic Aerospace Industry, in coordination with U.S. manufacturer Lockheed Martin. The head of Greece's joint chiefs of staff, Gen. Constantinos Floros, said the program's successful and timely completion "is an issue of the highest national importance."

"Any potential aggressor will have to think twice or thrice before trying their luck," once the upgrade is completed, he said at Monday's presentation.
