Iran unveils 'Alborz' and 'Borhan' air defense systems

Tehran Times, September 1, 2021

"Alborz" and "Borhan" air defense systems were unveiled with the commander of the Army Air Defense Force Brigadier General Alireza Sabahifard in attendance on Wednesday morning. Alborz fuzzy array, a three-dimensional radar system, has been produced with the aim of intercepting and detecting long-range aerial targets with low radar cross-section and stealth. The maximum radar range of this system is 450 km and is able to identify targets at low altitude. Alborz Radar is also able to track 300 targets simultaneously. The Borhan System is a command-and-control weapons center at low altitude as the last line of command in the point-defense of command-and-control air defense network.

Iran, France top diplomats discuss JCPOA

reported. Le Drian expressed his concern with regard to all the nuclear activities carried out by Iran in violation of a 2015 nuclear deal with world powers.

Indian FM: Expansion of Ties with Iran Necessary

In a relevant development in July, Iranian President-elect Seyed Ebrahim Rayeesi underlined that Iran and India play a key role in strengthening collective efforts to establish security in the region.

Iran Holds Naval Drills in Persian Gulf

Iran says siege of Panjshir Valley contravenes international law

The Iranian Foreign Ministry said on Monday that the blockade of the Panjshir

Valley in north of Kabul by the Taliban contravenes international law and humanitarian law. The ministry reiterated Tehran's position that there is only a political solution to the issues surrounding the Panjshir Valley. "There is only political solution to Panjshir and the siege of Panjshir is by no means acceptable in terms of international law and humanitarian law," Foreign Ministry spokesman Saeed Khatibzadeh told a regular news briefing. Khatibzadeh said reports from Panjshir are "worrying". He added the attack on the province is condemned in the strongest terms. Khatibzadeh said the "martyrdom" of Afghan leaders is a "source of regret".

"No side must allow that this course lead to fratricide," he said, adding that the Taliban should abide by international law.

He went on to say that "starving" the people of Panjshir and "cutting their water and electricity is a cause of concern and regret."

Iran warns against miscalculation at upcoming IAEA board meeting

Iranian Foreign Ministry spokesman Saeed Khatibzadeh on Monday warned against any miscalculation in the next meeting of the International Atomic Energy Agency Board of Governors. "The next meeting of the Board of Governors is a regular one. I have said before, and I emphasize now, that neither side should make a miscalculation, not go in a direction that affects the negotiations in Vienna," Khatibzadeh said when asked about a possible visit by Rafael Grossi, the International Atomic Energy

Agency chief, to Iran on the eve of the board meeting. Speaking to reporters in his regular news briefing, he said, “The political use of the Agency’s technical platform will lead to a different response from Iran.”

Iran draws red lines on Afghanistan

In the first sign of turnabout, Iran issued warnings in multiple directions as Taliban forces announced the “conquest” of the last opposition foothold in the Panjshir valley. Speaking at a weekly press briefing on Monday, Khatibzadeh warned about foreign meddling in Panjshir, the last stronghold of opposition against the new order led by Ahmad Massoud who is the son of legendary anti-Taliban commander Ahmad Shah Massoud. Khatibzadeh also strongly condemned the Taliban attack on the valley and described the death of opposition leaders there as “martyrdom,” a major indication of Iranian resentment at the Taliban’s inchoate political deliberations to form a government. Responding to a question about the Pakistani involvement in the battle for Panjshir, Khatibzadeh said, “The news coming out of Panjshir is concerning. Last night’s attacks [on Panjshir] are condemned in the strongest terms. Martyrdom of Afghan leaders is deeply regrettable.” Khatibzadeh said Iran was reviewing the reports of foreign intervention. “This should be reviewed,” he asserted.

Quds force chief: Tehran won’t allow developments in Afghanistan to harm Iran

Quds Force Commander Esmail Qaani has said Iran will not allow the developments in Afghanistan to “harm the security of the country,” a member of the Parliament National Security and Foreign Policy Committee told the Mehr news agency in an interview published on Tuesday. The remarks by Ebrahim Rezaei comes as the Iranian parliament held a closed-door session on Afghanistan on Monday during which IRGC Quds Force commander briefed the MPs about the developments in the country. “In this session, the commander of the Quds Force of the IRGC insisted that the Islamic Republic of Iran proved the ‘most prudent’ country and adopted good position” due to the “deep view” that the Leader of the Islamic Revolution has toward regional and international developments,” the MP added.

Germany arrests man for shipping equipment for Iran's nuclear program

German police arrested a German-Iranian man suspected of exporting equipment to be used in Iran's nuclear and missile

programs in breach of European Union sanctions, Germany's federal prosecutor said on Tuesday. The suspect, identified only as Alexander J. under privacy rules, had shipped equipment worth 1.1 million euros to an Iranian whose company in Iran was blacklisted by the EU as a front to procure equipment for nuclear and rocket programs. The GBA general prosecutor's office said the suspect was approached in 2018 and 2019 to procure laboratory equipment. He shipped two spectrometers procured for 166,000 euros (\$196,510.80) to Iran in Jan. 2020, and six months later shipped another two, procured for 388,000 euros.

Iraq announces supporting the Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty

The Peshmerga determines the area of the Turkish movement inside the Iraqi territory

Yawar told The Iraqi News Agency (INA) that "the file of Turkish violations is related to the Iraqi sovereignty and is the responsibility of the federal government;" clarifying that "Turkish warplanes penetrate Iraqi airspace daily at an estimated distance of 250 km." He added that "Turkish forces are entering Iraqi territory 45 kilometers wide and 200 kilometers long without any condemnation" noting that "Turkey is using

the fight against the PKK as a pretext to violate the Iraqi sovereignty."

CTS reveals new details about its Ops and identifies areas where ISIS remnants exist

Numan, told the Iraqi News Agency (INA), that "The recent operations carried out by the Counter-Terrorism Service are part of its ongoing operations to pursue ISIS remnants,". In response to a question about the possibility ISIS return, Al-Numan confirmed, "These gangs exist in separate areas, especially the difficult terrain in Kirkuk province and valleys linking Kirkuk with other provinces such as Nineveh and Diyala up to Sulaymaniyah," explaining that , "ISIS takes these areas as hideouts ,preparing to lunch terrorist operations". Al-Numan excluded the return of ISIS terrorist gangs, as he indicated that "there are no indications of the return of these gangs, because all cities are secured, especially Kirkuk."

Iraq-US agreement to hold a meeting on ending the military presence

The Iraqi government agreed with the United States of America, today, Thursday, to hold a meeting on ending the military presence at the end of the year. The media office of the Prime Minister said in a statement received by the Iraqi News Agency (INA), that "the Prime Minister, Commander in Chief of the Armed Forces, Mustafa Al-Kadhimi, received an American military delegation headed by the Commander of the US Central Command, First Lieutenant General Kenneth McKenzie, accompanied by the American ambassador to Iraq Matthew Tueller," noting that "the Prime Minister stressed during the meeting the importance of

concerted international efforts against the threat of terrorism and extremist takfiri ideology, which threatens the region and the world at large.". The statement continued, "It was agreed during the meeting to hold a new meeting of the Iraqi Military Technical Committee and its American counterpart, in order to implement the remaining steps of the strategic dialogue outputs, especially with regard to ending the presence of American combat forces at the end of this year, after the reduction of the level of military representation to the leadership was achieved, in line with the new non-combat phase of its role in Iraq.

JOC: No American request to stay in Iraq

Israeli Navy holds joint security patrol with US 5th fleet

The Israel Navy participated in a combined maritime security patrol with the US Naval Forces Central Command's 5th Fleet in the Red Sea for the first time on Tuesday. Three Israeli ships – the *INS Eilat* and two patrol boats – sailed alongside the guided-missile cruiser *USS Monterey* and a US Navy P-8A Poseidon maritime patrol aircraft that flew overhead. The forces also drilled on search and rescue scenarios, air defense, high-value unit defense and small boat operations, as well as tactical defensive maneuvers.

New undercover police unit formed to clamp down on crime in Arab communities

The Israel Police on Tuesday unveiled a new undercover unit tasked with tackling rampant crime and violence in Arab Israeli communities. The Sinai Unit was introduced in a ceremony attended by Police Commissioner Kobi Shabtai. It will

include 45 undercover officers, who will target hotspots and organized crime in Arab communities throughout the country. It will be the first undercover unit tasked with combating crime, rather than terrorism, and will be tasked primarily with enforcement among Israeli citizens.

Israel inaugurates Chinese-run Haifa port terminal, in likely boost for economy

Israel on Wednesday officially inaugurated a new port terminal in Haifa Bay, the first of two recently built private port terminals that are expected to fuel competition, decrease import costs, and present a boon for the Israeli economy. China's state-owned Shanghai International Port Group (SIPG) won the tender in 2015 to operate the commercial shipping facility for 25 years, an arrangement that stoked controversy in Israel and abroad. \$1.7b terminal operated by state-owned Shanghai firm to handle large vessels of some 18,000 containers; Transportation Minister Michaeli says it will accelerate trade, lower prices. The project's proximity to Israel's submarines, among other issues, raised security concerns, especially after reports revealed that neither the cabinet nor the National Security Council had any input on the deal. The project also raised the ire of the US, which sometimes docks military vessels in Haifa.

Syrian missile launched towards Israel, debris found in Tel Aviv

Israel Police's Bomb Disposal Unit recovered pieces of debris from a Syrian surface-to-air missile (SAM) found in northern Tel Aviv on Friday morning.

Russian military sources stated that 21 of 24 Israeli missiles were shot down during the attack last night. IDF released a statement on Friday confirming a Syrian missile was launched towards Israel during the early hours of Friday morning. The missile detonated over the Mediterranean Sea, according to the IDF. The IDF also destroyed the launcher and a number of SA5 batteries right after the missiles were fired from Syria.

Israel's Rafael Advanced Defense Systems is in talks for the sale of Spike LR2 anti-tank guided missiles to Serbia, regional director Al Zaher said. "We are acting in Serbia together with state-owned defence products manufacturer Jugoimport-SDPR and we are working on the promotion of Spike LR2 rockets," Zaher said in a video file posted on the website of Serbian public broadcaster RTS on Thursday. If the business with Jugoimport succeeds, then the Israeli company will also offer other solutions like the Spike ER and NLOS missiles that have a much longer range, Zaher said on the sidelines of Kecskemet

International Airshow in Hungary. The most advanced Spike LR2 version is currently used by Israel, Slovakia, Estonia and Australia. The missiles are made by German-based Eurospike, a subsidiary of Rafael, RTS reported.

"Unfortunately, there won't be stability in Syria, or in the wider Middle East, while there is an Iranian presence," Lapid said. "Iran is the world's number one exporter of terror."

Israeli firm unveils autonomous armed robot to patrol battle zones, borders

An Israeli defense contractor on Monday unveiled a remote-controlled armed robot it says can patrol battle zones, track infiltrators and open fire. The unmanned vehicle is the latest addition to the world of drone technology, which is rapidly reshaping the modern battlefield. The four-wheel-drive robot presented Monday in Lod was developed by the state-owned Israel Aerospace Industries' "REX MKII." It is operated by an electronic tablet and can be equipped with two machine guns, cameras and sensors, said Rani Avni, deputy head of the company's autonomous systems division. The robot can gather intelligence for ground troops, carry injured

soldiers and supplies in and out of battle, and strike nearby targets.

Gantz: Israel could accept return to Iran nuke deal if US has 'plan B'

Lebanon has been run by a caretaker government since August 10, 2020 when Diab and his cabinet resigned en masse following the catastrophic explosion at Beirut port.

At least 65 dead in battle for Marib, Yemen: Military

Sixty-five members of the Iran-backed Houthi militia and pro-government forces have been killed in renewed fighting for the strategic Yemeni city of Marib, a military official told AFP on Thursday. The clashes erupted when the Houthis attacked pro-government positions south of the city, making progress despite losing dozens of fighters in coalition air strikes. “Twenty-two pro-government [forces] were killed and 50 others were wounded, while 43 Houthi [militia] were also killed in the last 48 hours,” a government military official said, in figures that were confirmed by other military and medical sources.

UAE connects second Barakah nuclear plant unit to national power grid

The United Arab Emirates has connected the second unit of its Barakah nuclear power plant to the national power grid, state news agency WAM said on Tuesday. The plant in the Al Dhafrah region of Abu Dhabi, one of the seven emirates making up the UAE and the nation’s capital, is the first nuclear power station in the Arab world and part of the Gulf oil producer’s efforts to diversify its energy mix. When completed Barakah, which is being built by Korea Electric Power Corp (KEPCO), will have four reactors with 5,600 megawatts (MW) of total capacity - equivalent to around 25 percent of the UAE’s peak demand.

'Greece violates Turkey's airspace, territorial waters in Aegean'

Apart from Greece's arming of islands near Turkey, in violation of long-standing treaties, Turkey also condemns Greek efforts to claim maximalist maritime territory in the Eastern Mediterranean and to confine Turkish waters to a small area in the south, although Turkey has more Mediterranean coastline in the region than any other country.

Erdogan heralds massive military complex to coordinate military, security agencies

Turkey has launched the construction of the massive military complex, the Crescent and Star, named after the symbols of its national flag, to bring the Defense Ministry, the chief of General Staff, and the headquarters of the land, air and navy forces under a single roof, with the stated aim of enhancing coordination between military institutions and their operational effectiveness. Dubbed "Turkey's Pentagon," the project will sprawl on an area of some 12.6 million square meters and have indoor spaces of 890,000 square meters to house up to 15,000 employees. A crescent-shaped structure in the middle of the complex will contain various conference halls, curving around a ceremonial ground of 23,000 square meters and facing a star-shaped structure to the south. The complex will be erected in Ankara's suburb of Baglica, not far from the new, high-security headquarters to which the National Intelligence Organization (MIT) moved last year.
