Azerbaijan shuts mosque linked to Iran supreme leader Khamenei

Alarabiya, October 5, 2021

Azerbaijan has closed a mosque linked to Iran's supreme leader, Iran's Tasnim news agency reported Tuesday, days after Tehran launched war games near their shared border in a move denounced by Baku. "The mosque and representative office of Seyyed Ali Akbar Ojaghnejad, representative of supreme leader (Ayatollah) Ali Khamenei in Baku, were sealed and closed today by order of the authorities of the Republic of Azerbaijan," Tasnim said, without giving further details. Ojaghnejad has held the post since 1996, according to the website of his office, which is located inside the mosque.

Azerbaijan's interior ministry spokesman Eskhan Zahidov said in a statement that the move was necessary because of "a surge in Covid-19 cases in several locations in Baku" and that the mosque's operation had been "suspended temporarily".

Azerbaijan says no Israelis on border, warns against Iran 'provocations'

Azerbaijan's State Border Service (SBS) rejected claims by Iranian officials that Israeli forces are present in Azerbaijan near the Iranian border, saying that Azerbaijan "does not need the support of foreign forces." Ahmed Ali Goudarzi, commander of Iran's Border Guard, claimed last week that Israeli forces are present in "sensitive areas" in neighboring countries and conducting intelligence and espionage work, advising Muslim countries "not to allow this," according to Iranian state

broadcaster IRIB. The Azeri SBS stated in response that there never have been, are not and never will be forces of any third country on Azerbaijan's border, according to the Azeri APA news source. The SBS added that it does not need the support of foreign forces.

Iran, Azerbaijan agree to mend ties, settle differences 'through dialogue'

Azerbaijan said Wednesday it had agreed with Iran to resolve a diplomatic crisis through dialogue weeks after ties soured over allegations Israel's military was active in Azerbaijan. Iran last month protested against what it said was the presence of its sworn enemy Israel in Azerbaijan and vowed to take any necessary action. It staged military exercises near its border with Azerbaijan, sparking criticism from officials in Baku, which has denied Iranian claims. Azerbaijan said Wednesday its Foreign Minister Jeyhun Bayramov had spoken by phone with Iranian counterpart Hossein Amir-Abdollahian and the pair had agreed to resolve differences through dialogue.

Iran unveils tactical Hormuz radar, Shams simulator

Hormuz is a tactical radar with average power and Shams simulator is a strategic long-range system. The aim behind designing and building Hormuz radar is to extract information with speed and identify the distance to target with high accuracy in order to give the information to the control center. Also, the indigenous Shams simulator has been built to face against ballistic missiles and some other targets.

If US is serious about nuclear talks, \$10b of Iranian assets must be unfrozen: Amir Abdollahian

Iranian Foreign Minister Hossein Amir Abdollahian told a televised program on Saturday night that if the Joe Biden administration is "serious" about reviving

the 2015 nuclear deal it should allow releasing at least 10 billion dollars of the Iranian assets held in foreign banks. "Americans tried to contact us in New York through various channels, and I told the intermediaries that if the U.S. had serious intentions, it should issue a serious signal. The serious sign is releasing at least \$ 10 billion of Iranian frozen money," Abdollahian asserted.

Iran planning to meet 50% of its energy needs from nuclear power plants: AEOI chief

Head of the Atomic Energy Organization of Iran (AEOI) Mohammad Eslami said Iran has set a goal to meet 50 percent of the country's demand for 10,000-16,000 MW of electricity by building new [nuclear] power plants with a combined capacity of 8,000 MW. Eslami made the remarks in an exclusive interview with Russia's Sputnik news agency. "The second priority of the organization is to develop the production of radiopharmaceuticals and the development of radiotracer generators," adding, "Today, these nuclear power products should be actively introduced in our country in medicine, industry, agriculture, and the environment." Asked whether Iran plans to increase uranium enrichment capacity, Eslami said: "Iran will operate within the framework of the Non-Proliferation Treaty (NPT), of which it is a member. Iran pledges not to develop or proliferate nuclear weapons. Iran is committed to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons. Moreover, under the law of the Islamic Republic and the fatwa of Iran's

supreme leader, the development of nuclear weapons is prohibited.”

Construction of Arak IR20 Reactor to begin within a year: MP

The rapporteur of Parliament’s Energy Commission said here on Sunday that according to the head of the Atomic Energy Organization of Iran (AEOI), the construction of Arak IR20 Reactor will start within a year. Mostafa Nakhaie while elaborating on Parliament’s Energy Commission’s Sunday meeting with the AEOI Head Mohammad Eslami, told the media representatives: Keeping in mind the industrial, technical, and expert level issues involved in the country’s nuclear industry, and the need to refrain from mere political and security approach about the issue, in today’s meeting the technical and specialist aspects of the matter were surveyed. He quoted Eslami as saying that the AEOI is planning to produce 8,000 megawatts of nuclear electricity by construction of more nuclear reactors, including the Arak IR20 Reactor.

US ready ‘to turn to other options’ if Iran fails to return to nuclear deal: Official

Speaking to reporters ahead of a visit to Washington by Israel’s National Security Council chief, the US official said meetings would focus on regional issues and, “of course, Iran.” White House National Security Council head Jake Sullivan is scheduled to meet his Israeli counterpart, Eyal Hulata, on Tuesday. His visit comes on the heels of Sullivan’s trip last week to Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates and Egypt.

Iran's FM says Saudi Arabia talks have progressed 'good distance'

Direct talks between Saudi Arabia and Iran have progressed a "good distance," Iranian Foreign Minister Hossein Amir-Abdollahian told reporters on Thursday. Saudi Arabia and Iran have taken a major step aimed at easing the tensions, confirming earlier this year that they held direct talks in Baghdad. Saudi Foreign Minister Prince Faisal bin Farhan confirmed that the kingdom held meetings over the weekend with officials from the new Iranian government led by ultraconservative President Ebrahim Raisi. The last round of talks took place on Sept. 21, he said, declining to name the location. "These discussions are still in the exploratory phase. We hope they will provide a basis to address unresolved issues between the two sides and we will strive and work to realize that," the Saudi diplomat said in a news conference Sunday. Amir-Abdollahian said the talks are

moving forward during a news conference in Beirut, Reuters reports.

Iranian state TV claims boats chased US Navy ship

Iranian state television aired footage Thursday claiming to show Iranian Revolutionary Guard fast boats approaching a US Navy ship, but the US has not confirmed the incident. A spokesperson for the US Navy's Fifth Fleet, Cdr. Tim Hawkins, told the Associated Press today that he was unaware of any recent unsafe encounters with Iranian vessels. Such run-ins have occurred occasionally in the Persian Gulf over the past several years. Fast approaches by Iranian boats, which the US often describes as "unsafe" and "unprofessional," have at times ceased for a period and later restarted without public explanation. Iran frequently denies US accusations surrounding such maneuvers.

Intel: US lifts Iran-related sanctions, says no connection to nuclear deal

The US Treasury Department delisted Iran-based entities on Friday that were sanctioned by the Trump administration for their alleged involvement in Iran's ballistic missile program. The department's Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) determined Mammut Industrial Group and its subsidiary, Mammut Diesel, are no

longer blocked under Executive Order 13382, which targets proliferators of weapons of mass destruction and their supporters. The two entities were removed from OFAC's list of Specially Designated Nationals. The Trump administration sanctioned Mammut Industrial Group and Mammut Diesel in September 2020, accusing them of being "key producers and suppliers of military-grade, dual-use goods for Iran's missile programs."

Eslami: Major difference between Safeguards cameras and those of JCPOA

Tehran Times, October 10, 2021

Mohammad Eslami, Vice President and Chief of the Atomic Energy Organization of Iran (AEOI), said on Saturday night that there is a great difference between the IAEA camera monitoring Iran's nuclear activities under the safeguard agreement with those installed under the 2015 nuclear deal, officially called the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA). Eslami said IAEA inspectors examine the monitoring cameras at the site in a specified time and install new card memories. The old memory cards are cut into pieces and put in a stamped pocket and given to the AEOI for storing. He said nobody can have access to these pieces. However, the issue is different with regard to cameras related to the JCPOA in a way that IAEA inspectors remove the old memory cards and stamp them and they are kept by the AEOI in a safe place and are not reviewed by anybody, Eslami explained. The nuclear chief added nobody is given access to the old cards and they are just replaced by new ones.

Iran's Army, IRGC Start Massive Air Defense Drills in Central Desert Region

Iran launches air defense exercises

The joint specialized air defense exercise of the Modafe'an-e Aseman-e Velayat (Defenders of Sky of Velayat) kicked off on Tuesday morning in Iran's central desert. The military drill kicked off with the deployment of indigenous missile, radar, reconnaissance, electronic warfare, communication systems, and visual surveillance network, Fars News reported. Announcing the start of the exercise, Brigadier General Qader Rahimzadeh, Commander of Khatam al-Anbia Air Defense Base, said in the first phase of air defense exercise, the deployment of defense systems with "the rapid reaction of operational forces in accordance with the principles of passive defense to deceive the enemy were carried out." Pointing to the use of indigenous air defense systems in the exercise, the commander of air defense base said stationing command and control systems, the indigenous Meraj radar systems, Fatah-2 radars, tactical

intelligence and reconnaissance systems, electro-optical systems and electronic warfare systems were used in the exercise.

Iran's Armed Forces Crush Mid-Altitude Targets in Military Drills

The Iranian Armed Forces conducted a successful test of shooting medium-altitude targets during military drills in the Central desert regions of the country by utilizing completely indigenous military hardware. Modafe'an-e Aseman-e Velayat 1400 (Defenders of Velayat Skies 1400), the military drills kicked off in the country's Central Desert on Tuesday, with the goal of practicing defensive maneuvers in the service of the country's "sensitive and vital" spots and testing the operational maneuverability of the Armed Forces' new-generation defensive equipment among other things. The first day of the major Air Defense drills by the various branches of Iran's Armed Forces saw the forces successfully laying into medium-altitude targets using completely indigenous military hardware. The drills have so far recruited the Islamic Republic of Iran Air Force (IRIAF) and Air Defense Force (IRIADF) as well as the Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC)'s Aerospace Division. Commander of Khatam al-Anbia Air Defense Base Brigadier General Qader Rahimzadeh specified the Air Defense systems deployed during the first day as the domestically-manufactured Mersad-16, Tabas, Khordad-3, and Khordad-15.

Blinken warns Iran 'time is running short' on nuclear deal return

"We're united in the proposition that Iran cannot be allowed to acquire a nuclear weapon," Blinken said in a joint press conference alongside his counterparts from the United Arab Emirates and Israel. IRGC Operates Its Domestically-Built Qods Radar for 1st Time in Drills

Domestically-Built Qods Radar was put into operation for the first time by the Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) Aerospace Force in the operational phase of the joint large-scale drills, codenamed Modafe'an-e Aseman-e Velayat 1400 (Defenders of Velayat Skies 1400) in Iran's Central Desert region. Qods Radar is able to monitor targets at a 500km range and altitude of over 90,000 feet. Tactical and single-vehicle capability, domestic software, the ability to deal with electronic warfare in various techniques, friend-enemy detection system and the ability to link with defense systems are among the characteristics of Qods radar system. Iran not getting the bomb any time soon - Military intelligence head

Despite enriching uranium at a level not seen before, Iran still has a long way to go before acquiring a nuclear bomb, according to Israel's Military Intelligence head Maj.-Gen. Tamir Hayman. According to Hayman, while the levels of enriched uranium are "disturbing," the Islamic Republic still has a long way to go before acquiring a functioning nuclear bomb that can threaten Israel. "There is an enriched amount [of uranium] in volumes that we have not seen before and it is disturbing. At the same time, in all other aspects of the Iranian nuclear project, we see no progress," Hayman said in an interview with Walla News. "Not in the weapons project, in the financial area, not in any other sector. Therefore the period of time that still remains of two years has not

changed. Because even from the moment you have a breakout, there is still a long way to go before a bomb," he said. "To the best of our knowledge, the directive has not changed and they are not heading toward a breakout. They are not heading toward a bomb right now: It may be in the distant future."

Lapid to meet Blinken in Washington next week

Amid Israeli threats, Iran touts successful test of anti-missile defense system

Turkish defense industry showcased a prototype of its domestically-produced short-range air defense system which will be used on naval platforms at the International Military Radar and Border Security Summit held in the capital Ankara between Oct. 5-6. The system was produced by the Machinery and Chemical Industry (MKE AŐ) and is expected to replace the U.S.-made Phalanx Close-in Weapon System (CIWS). It will provide protection against guided missiles, air-to-surface missiles, cruise missiles, unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs), planes and helicopters. The system, whose tests are scheduled to begin at the end of this year, can be placed on any ship with a combat management system. It is expected to enter the inventory by 2023.

Turkish advanced multifunctional UAV testing flight by month's end

Turkey will soon have a state-of-the-art multifunctional unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) testing flight, which can be utilized as a self-defense deterrent against drones or

used in an assault, said a senior official of a Turkish manufacturing company. Guray Ali Canli, a member of the executive board of Transvaro, which manufactured Fedai, told Anadolu Agency that the device has a protection system developed to stop UAV/drone attacks, but the vehicle itself can be used for an attack in the future if needed. He said their primary goal is to shoot down armed drones and UAVs, but by changing the warhead, Fedai can also be used as an anti-tank, anti-personnel defense system, or a vehicle capable of attacking itself. "The wing and follower tracking mechanism structure of the Fedai is different from all other products," Canli explained, adding that when the threat approaches, it explodes on the target with its own optical search system.

Biden administration reportedly backs Turkey's \$6B F-16 deal request

Turkey's request for Lockheed Martin-made F-16 fighter jets and modernization kits to upgrade its existing warplanes is valued at \$6 billion (TL 54.02 billion), according to Turkish sources who spoke to two different media organizations Tuesday. Considering U.S. Congress' opposition to Ankara purchasing arms due to several lingering issues, it was thought that it would be difficult to win approval for the deal, however, reports have said that the new U.S. administration supports it. Turkey on Sept. 30 sent a formal request to the U.S. to purchase 40 new F-16 Block 70 aircraft and nearly 80 kits to modernize its F-16 fighters, two officials familiar with the matter were cited as saying by Bloomberg. The report said President Recep Tayyip

Erdoğan is expected to hold a meeting with U.S. President Joe Biden at the upcoming global G-20 summit. There has been no official announcement or meeting scheduled as of yet.

UAE's Abdullah bin Zayed meets US, Israel FMs, plans to bolster religious coexistence

Sheikh Abdullah said the three-way meeting reflects the US's commitment to build bridges of cooperation between two nations that are "committed to achieving advancement and development." "Our presence here today reaffirms our commitment to the necessity of changing the prevailing conditions in the region in the right direction," Sheikh Abdullah noted.
